As we continue to closely monitor the COVID-19 outbreak, it has come to our attention that an ACS Athens family has been in close contact with a group that recently tested positive for the virus. According to the Ministry of Health, close contact is defined as face-to-face with a confirmed case or in close contact for at least 15 minutes or more in the same closed area for a minimum of two hours.

Though the family has been tested, we are still awaiting results.

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I would like to inform you that we will close the school for one week, March 9-13, as a precautionary measure to ensure the safety of our school community. We will also be disinfecting the classrooms and other areas of the campus during this time.

We want to assure you that learning will continue to take place as our faculty is prepared to work with students on-line. You will receive further information/details about this from your principals.
