Please be informed that mid-year exams will begin on January 20, 2020 (with the exception of the IB/AP courses, whose exams will begin on January 10th). The exam schedule for all courses (except for IB/AP) is as follows:

As per school policy, only a doctor's note will excuse students from missing an exam. Students who do not have IB mock exams in the afternoon must leave the campus at 12:00 noon, unless they have scheduled appointments with specific teachers for a make-up exam. The students should spend their time at home preparing for their next exam. We believe that the exam process is an important learning experience and it is expected that students approach it seriously.

Please note that in order to accommodate the variety and demands of the **IB and AP exams, IB and AP course students will start the mock exams on January 10 and will end January 31.** The mock exam schedule for both IB and AP courses has been sent out in a separate email by the IB office.
