Guide to Admission

Please read carefully:

ACS Athens welcomes applications for admission throughout the year. (Restrictions may apply to students applying from local schools). Please ensure that all of the Admission Procedures below have been observed before you submit the application to the Enrollment Management Office.

- Complete the ACS Athens **Admission Application** in paper or online at www.acs.gr/admission-guide.

Submit the following documents:

- At least **two years of report cards or transcripts**. High school applicants (Grades 9-12) need to submit **official final transcripts** from grade 9 to current grade. If not in English, transcripts must be officially translated.
- **Two Faculty Recommendation Forms*** from latest school attended (Grades 6-12).
- **The Special Education Services Form*** from latest school Guidance Counselor or Principal (Grades Jr. Kindergarten - 12). All confidential records, reports or testing results (if available) must also accompany this form.
- The **Student Profile Form*** from latest school attended (Grades JK-5)
- A **handwritten personal statement** by the student (Grades 6-12).
- Copies of **passport** and/or other **citizenship documents**.

Elementary students (Grades JK-5) are assessed through a personal **interview** with the Elementary School Counselor.

Middle School/Academy Students (Grades 6-12) are tested in **English and Math** to determine **academic eligibility for admission** according to the ACS Athens academic standards.

Notice to students with Greek Surnames

According to the Greek Law, students in grades K-6 with Greek Surnames are required to attend Greek Schools. These students must apply for approval from the Greek Education Ministry in order to register at ACS Athens. As soon as parents are informed of their child's acceptance, they will be requested to fill and submit the **Registration Approval Form - Αίτηση Έγκρισης Εγγραφής** (available at the office of Enrollment Management). This Form and all supporting documents must be filed **prior to registration**.



Please Note: Admission Applications are considered on a first-come-first-served basis. Receipt of the above records does not automatically mean that the student will be admitted. ACS Athens reserves the right to communicate directly with the previous school(s), before or after admitting a student, for verification purposes.
