COVID VACCINATION INFO FOR NON-GREEK CITIZENS

Right now, we are at phase 2 of the immunization program. Due to the different types of vaccinations and their effectiveness, people who are over 75 years old, 60-64 and health care workers are currently being vaccinated.

In case you do not have a Greek Medical Insurance Number (AMKA), which is required to get a vaccination and belong in the groups mentioned above, you can visit https://emvolio.gov.gr/aitisi or go to the nearest KEP office. To register for the vaccination, you only need your passport and your Greek Tax Identification Number (AFM in Greek), which every individual resident of Greece over 18 years old should have regardless of nationality.
