After her husband was released from jail, Khadija went into hiding, not being able to see her son.

The story of Khadija is just one of many sad and unbelievable stories of mistreatment and lack of protection around the world.

It is time to make a stand. This is why I want to launch a campaign in the United Nations. We must raise awareness of domestic violence, and get world leaders to join the fight. Leaders must be held accountable for the situation for women in their countries.
